

Disciplinary Guidelines

Team Alameda



The Team Alameda Board reserves the right to discipline any member of the Club who breaches the Code of Conduct.

Should a serious breach of the Code of Conduct be determined, the Board will assemble any available evidence of the breach, including interviews with other members. The information will be presented and discussed at a Board Meeting when a vote on disciplinary actions may be taken. Actions will be determined by a majority vote.

Disciplinary actions may take the form of a warning, Letter of Reprimand, or temporary or full revocation of membership. Such a decision will be made by the Board on a majority vote. The member's name will be treated with utmost confidentiality and not appear in the Board Minutes. Instead, such proceedings will be saved to a separate file, only available to serving Board members.

If the disciplined member wishes to appeal the decision of the Board, then a written appeal may be made to the President, who will relay the appeal to the Board in a timely fashion.

In the event of an expulsion, the excluded member is required to return all equipment, documents and finances belonging to the Club within seven (7) days. They will not be entitled to any full or partial refund of annual membership fee.
